
Guideline to register for PART-66 | CAR (DGCA-EASA-GCAA) Module Examinations

Important Notes


- Initial exams for AU Aviation students will be free.
- Only initial exams will be registered by the School of Aviation administrators.
- For <u>re-sits</u>, students need to register online and will be charged <u>50KD</u>.

Terms & Conditions


- . For modules with MCQ and Essay(s), both papers must be successfully completed in AU to qualify for issuance of the Certificate of Recognition(s)
- . Registration and/or cancellation must be made no later than 2 working days before the examination date
- AU may cancel examinations due to insufficient candidates enrolling for a particular examination, in this case AU shall inform the candidates by e-mail at least 3 days
 before any examination
- · Photographic ID must be produced prior to entry to the examination venue
- · Candidates who cannot produce photographic ID will not be allowed to enter the examination room
- A failed module examination taken at any competent Authority/organizations cannot be retaken within 90 days
- A candidate who has failed a single module 3 times must wait 1 year from the latest attempt before retaking the module examination
- A candidate that has been disqualified from taking examinations from any competent Authority/organizations for a period of 12 months due to examination misconduct/cheating are not allowed to sit for any exams. Examinations done during this period will be invalid and no Certificate of Recognition will be issued
- For GCAA examination only
- . Both MCQ and Essay paper of the same module must be completed if either have been failed following three consecutive attempts after the waiting period of 1 year

I declare that any applications relate to examinations, I have not taken and failed any Part 66 CAR 66 module examinations within the 90 days from the last attempt and that if I have failed the same module 3 times, the waiting period of 1 year has been met.

AU reserves the right to reject or withdraw this application at any time should any statements or evidence provided found to be false.


